Kindergarten Objectives

HANDWRITING

Holds pencil with proper grip.

Copies shapes.

Copies upper case & lower case letters, later writing them from memory.

Copies numerals 0-9, later writing them from memory.

Copies words & sentences, capitalizing the first word and using end marks.

PHONICS/READING

Visually matches/discriminates letters.

Identifies rhyming words.

Matches words with same initial sounds.

Names upper and lower case lettes.

Produces letter sounds for memory.

Blends letter sounds together to form words.

Read one-vowel and two-vowel words, and pre-primer sight words.

Reads short sentences and stories.

Marks short, long, and silent vowels, special sounds in words.

MATH

Counts, identifies, and writes numbers by ones, tens, fives, and twos to 100.

Tells and writes time to the hour, half-hour, and quarter-past.

Identifies coins and their values: penny, dime, nickel, quarter to 100/dollar.

Identifies ordinal numbers 1st to 10th, first, last, middle. Orders smallest-largest.

Identifies concepts of greater than, less than, equal, after, before, and between.

Identiifes ½.

Measures longer/shorter, using inch.

Adds combinations to 10.

Subtracts 1 and all of a number to 5.

BIBLE

Memorizes Bible verses.

Listens to Bible stories.

Attends chapel programs.

SCIENCE/LANGUAGE ENRICHMENT

Reads "Weekly Reader" with the teacher.

Participates in unit studies.

Listens to teacher-read stories.

Memorizes poems, songs, finger-plays.
